The following statements inside this reflection letter are just a few takeaway points from level #1.

Dr. Zadai said that Psalm twenty-nine was talking about how God is holding back a lot to protect us. I believe that his statement was true because it seems like when Adam and Eve sinned, God withdrew His presence so that it would not consume and destroy them—because God is awesome, and sinful man is not, so God holds back to protect the sinful man whom God loves.

On the other hand, God won't allow things to go on for a long time before he brings judgment. For the most part, people are usually out for themselves and are not submitted to The Holy Spirit, but they are walking in the flesh because people have selfish agendas. Therefore, God can't trust you if you're not humble, and not allowing yourself to be a broken vessel.

And a lot of things are sometimes left undone, with unresolved conflicts with other people, that the devil will send your way to offend you and break your momentum. At the same time, God can remove all of our limitations in life, but we have to remain humble and not prideful so that He won't have to resist us and our ministries.

Even Jesus had a price to pay in his sufferings, and if we want to walk in the anointing, we have to be willing to humble ourselves too, just like Jesus. We have to be willing to pay the price of working with a lukewarm church, we have to be willing to be hated and despised like Jesus was to walk in the anointing. Brokenness and humility are not bad things, as you humble yourself and walk in character, you can settle in and let God exalt you instead of doing what other prideful ministers do who exalt themselves and are later humbled by God. And sometimes you do get attacked because you are doing God's will because the enemy won't attack somebody who is not a threat.

On top of all this, you have to limit yourself to those that you are exposed to, especially those that are in sinful bondage to demons, for their evil spirits will want to cause you to sin too, and cause you to go astray from God's will.
