Honestly, this course simply felt like a review of information that I already heard in Dr. Kevin Zadai's previous sermons. Such as the concept of praying only to God the Father, but I like to talk to Jesus and The Holy Spirit too. Especially since the body of Christ is supposed to have a relationship with God in Jesus.

But I liked the teaching about being wrapped up in Christ, it reminded me of the famous Bible verse in the book of Romans, which states:

"But put ye on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make not provision for the flesh, to fulfil the lusts thereof."

Romans 13:14 (KJV)

I also enjoyed the lesson about not getting prayers answered, but sometimes people don't get healed not just because of unforgiveness, but because of unbelief. Sometimes you have to get away from people who operate with hearts of unbelief to get your prayers answered. To use a perfect example, Mark chapter eight talks about a blind man who came to Jesus for healing, but Jesus had to take that man out of the village of Bethsaida because it was saturated in unbelief and doubt. When Jesus took him out of that town, he had to pray over the blind man two different times before he was healed, and then Jesus warned that man to stay out of Bethsaida.

"And they came to Bethsaida. And some people brought to him a blind man and begged him to touch him. And he took the blind man by the hand and led him out of the village, and when he had spit on his eyes and laid his hands on him, he asked him, Do you see anything? And he looked up and said, I see people, but they look like trees, walking. Then Jesus laid his hands on his eyes again; and he opened his eyes, his sight was restored, and he saw everything clearly. And he sent him to his home, saying, Do not even enter the village."

Mark 8:22-26 (ESV)

Aside from this eye-opening reality, the lecture about the hard-hearted lukewarm ministers who blame the congregation for having a lack of faith when they don't receive from God was a good example. Especially with the topic of Jesus who was told that he believed, and to help him with his unbelief, he was asking Jesus to help accommodate him, for Jesus to help him walk into it, it being belief in Jesus for personal miracles.

I know that the five-fold is supposed to help the body of Christ in miracles for today, the only problem, is that most modern-day pastors do partner with cessationism—better known as the doctrines of devils. And they work as the synagogue of satan to push out the rising five-fold in their churches, sabotaging and destroying them before they can cultivate.
