I liked this teaching, I especially appreciated the fact that there were some references to The Apostle Paul; telling Timothy to wage war with his prophecies:

"This charge I commit unto thee, son Timothy, according to the prophecies which went before on thee, that thou by them mightest war a good warfare."

1 Timothy 1:18 (KJV)

Also, he tells pastor Timothy to fan the words of his prophecy in the fire:

"That is why I remind you to fan into flame the gracious gift of God, [that inner fire—the special endowment] which is in you through the laying on of my hands [with those of the elders at your ordination]."

2 Timothy 1:6 (Amplified Bible)

Once upon a disciple's time, in 2016 I stepped out in faith by doing something that I knew would please God, and I trusted that God would help me in my journey. Revelation 19:10 (KJV)
